Classes & Skill Levels

Novice/Beginner (Free Entry)

A groomer who has less than 2 years' experience in grooming which is defined as any groomer who has used grooming equipment including but not limited to clippers, scissors, stripping equipment or any other type of grooming equipment. Any person who has been or is a bather/brusher technician for more than two years but has used the listed equipment for under two years still qualifies as a novice. A Novice groomer must move up to open when they have two years or more experience as per this definition, or have won at Novice level competing against 4 or more competitors. This applies to each class competed in.

Open

Groomers who have won a Novice Class or have over 2 years' experience or a novice who voluntarily choose this class. An Open groomer must move up to Masters when they have won at this level competing against 4 or more competitors. This applies to each class competed in.

Masters

Groomer who have won the Open Class or a first place in the Creative Class or voluntarily chooses this class. (Certified Master Groomers do not have to enter at this level, they may choose Open or Masters level.)
