WILDLIFE **TRAFFICKING**

Wildlife trafficking is a lucrative global crime and a major threat to Australian native wildlife, which is being cruelly smuggled out at an alarming rate. **Caroline Zambrano investigates** what the Australian Government is doing to protect our wildlife from abuse and extinction.

For syndicates that smuggle animals it's a numbers game. Many animals won't survive the journey

Poaching of wildlife species is big business. Every year millions of Australian native wildlife are sold around the world to feed the insatiable greed of cashed-up collectors.

Earlier this year, news reports revealed a kookaburra on sale for US\$1200 in a pet shop in America. In Australia it's illegal to keep a kookaburra as a pet, but such laws don't exist in the U.S. state of Virginia, where the bird was found.

Whilst some wildlife trade in Australia is legal, many animals are captured from the wild illegally to supply an illicit global wildlife trade worth billions of dollars. Some of these smuggled species are listed as endangered.

Sadly, illegal wildlife trade has made some species, like African Grey parrots, critically endangered or even locally extinct, according to World Animal Protection. In fact, Australia is the leader of the highest mammal extinction rate of species anywhere in the world¹!

What's more horrifying is the suffering they go through. Many of these animals don't survive the journey across the border, slowly suffocating their way to cashed-up collectors across the ocean. It's clear wildlife smugglers will do anything to avoid getting caught, even if it means putting an animal's life at risk.

Wildlife trafficking is the fourth most lucrative global crime, according to the World Wildlife Fund (WWF). The illegal trade in wildlife is a global problem, estimated to be worth up to US\$ 20 billion per year and getting worse, according to the International Criminal Police Organization (INTERPOL)².

"Wildlife trafficking has surged in recent years, generating billions in illicit profits. Simply put, criminals are helping themselves to the environment's precious resources without a care for the cost to our planet," said INTERPOL Secretary General Jürgen Stock in a press release.

INTERPOL's transcontinental operation (codenamed Thunderstorm) against the illegal trade in wildlife (and timber), and involving 92 countries including Australia, has seen hundreds of seizures worth millions of dollars worldwide, as well as suspects arrested. It also revealed how wildlife trafficking groups use the same routes as criminals involved in other crime areas – often hand-in-hand with tax evasion, corruption, money laundering and violent crime.

It's difficult to know exactly how much of Australia's wildlife is smuggled out of the land Down Under. According to an ABC news report from a year ago, convicted animal smuggler Niall Cooke said Australians would be horrified if they knew how many animals are dying in black market trade while being smuggled to cashed-up collectors in Europe and Asia.³ More disturbingly, organised crime is increasingly getting involved, he added.

How serious is the Australian Government about protecting its unique wildlife? Pet Industry News explores how various departments are working to crack down on illegal wildlife trade.

The Australian Government is a signatory of CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora) and having a national environmental law, the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act). The EPBC Act enables the Government to join with the states and territories in providing a national scheme of environment and heritage protection and biodiversity conservation.

A number of Australian Government departments have a role to play in the detection and enforcement of laws designed to protect our environment including wildlife. These include the Australian Federal Police, Department of the Environment, Australian Border Force, Australian Fisheries Management Authority, Australian Maritime Safety Authority, Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service and state government agencies.

Wildlife trafficking has severe penalties including fines of up to \$210,000 and imprisonment for up to 10 years, as listed on the Department of Environment and Energy website. Australia's state and territory governments also have laws on keeping wildlife within their borders and regulate the expert (and import) of wildlife across their borders with permits. In serious cases, breaches to permits can lead to the suspension or cancellation of permits, and prosecution.

Leading wildlife trade organisation TRAFFIC states, "the conservation community has never been so well equipped to combat the motivations, rewards and enablers of wildlife crime. Yet, advances in technology and rising globalisation mean that wildlife traffickers and highly organised criminal syndicates are increasingly able to capitalise on regulatory loopholes and weak enforcement."



ALARMING REPORT ON AUSTRALIA'S WILDLIFE PROTECTION POLICIES

In November 2015, the Australian Auditor General's Department completed an alarming report on legal and illegal wildlife trade, revealing the effectiveness of the Department of Environment and Department of Immigration and Border Protection (two main government departments armed with the responsibility of wildlife trade provisions) have been undermined by the absence of appropriate and tailored policies and procedures ⁴.

The report made recommendations for improvement, including better

monitoring and reporting of wildlife trade regulation. In February 2017 the Australian Auditor General's Department conducted a performance audit in the Department of the Environment and Energy to determine if progress had been made towards implementing the recommendations. The report findings showed progress in addressing the recommendations.

The Australian Government remains resolute in its efforts to tackle illegal wildlife trade, said a spokesperson from the Department of Environment and Energy.

"The Department takes attempts to illegally smuggle wildlife into and out of Australia very seriously and will continue to work with Australian law enforcement agencies, including Australian Border Force and the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources," said the spokesperson. "Australia is working internationally to combat illegal wildlife trade to ensure that the penalties match the seriousness of the crime, and to make sure international organised crime groups can't keep the profits from illegal wildlife trade."

AUSTRALIAN BORDER FORCE ON THE JOB

The trafficking of native Australian wildlife is a serious issue for the Australian Border Force as it works with other federal and state agencies, which tie in with their network overseas, explained ABF Acting Superintendent John Fleming. "Over time, there has been a gradual increase in cross border wildlife smuggling of Australian native wildlife as it has become a more valuable commodity," he said.

"Wildlife smuggling is a lucrative trade and criminal syndicates and individuals can make significant profits by exporting and selling Australia's unique native fauna overseas. Many animals smuggled out can fetch large sums of money. Recent lizards exported can fetch up to \$10k per animal!"

Traffickers mainly use international mail and target lizards because they can be easily hidden in luggage, packed in socks, boxes of cereal or bag of chips and legs taped together, said Superintendent Fleming.

"The way traffickers are putting wildlife into packages are quite cruel, it's quite upsetting," he said. "For syndicates that smuggle animals it's a numbers game. Many animals won't survive the journey."

Police also generally find that these criminal syndicates are involved with other activities, like narcotics and importation of illegal tobacco, he added.

According to recent ABF detection data, the native species being smuggled out of Australia included shingleback lizards, eastern spiny tailed skinks, geckos, blue tongue lizards and gidgee skins. The animals were aimed mostly for the Asian market to be sold as pets.

"The majority of the international mail



parcels were posted from Melbourne and Sydney and destined for China, Hong Kong, Indonesia and Russia. The boxes were labelled as toys, kids and baby clothing, shoes, school bags and bags of chips," said Superintendent Fleming.

In the first quarter of 2018/2019 financial year, the ABF officers stopped a total of 20 separate consignments containing more than 110 reptiles from being illegally exported overseas.

"Since these detections, we haven't seen numbers this high but are still intercepting packages containing reptiles on a regular basis, most commonly through our mail stream," he said. "We also occasionally see people attempting to bring in exotic wildlife from overseas. It's not a growing problem. We see less coming into Australia."

In the spirit of national collaboration and coordination to combat illicit trafficking of Australian wildlife, the Victorian Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) works closely with the ABF, the Department of Environment and Energy (DOEE), Australia Post, RSPCA Victoria and other agencies across the states and territories.

Whilst federal agencies are looking at investigating wildlife trafficking from a national perspective, DELWP is taking a similar approach - in our current investigation, said DELWP's Manager of Intelligence and Investigations, Iain Bruce.

"In our investigation, Operation SHEFFIELD, we wanted to fully understand the level of sophistication and number of people involved in this detailed, long term investigation targeting wildlife crime " said Mr Bruce.

What authorities do know is that smugglers are targeting reptiles because they are easier to transport and conceal. Specifically of interest are lizards -Blue tongue, Shingleback, Skink, Gecko, Water Dragon and Lace Monitor and snakes. Smugglers are also after native mammals like Echidnas and Sugar Gliders.

"The way these animals are concealed are extremely cruel; taped up head to tail to avoid animals making any noise," he said. "Some come out paralysed, some found dead and others very close to

death. They are assessed, treated and sometimes euthanised."

Mr Bruce said authorities prioritise their investigations according to how rare the species are – the rarer species are involved, the higher priority to investigate.

DELWP together with Australia Post ran one of Australia's biggest investigations (Operation Sheffield) into illegal wildlife trafficking, leading to search warrants across Victoria and multiple arrests.

A press release from the Minister of Energy, Environment and Climate Change, Lily D'Ambrosio reported more than 150 lizards have been seized since the smuggling operation was discovered in June 2018 by Australia Post and the ABF – with a total estimated street value of more than \$550,000. The smuggling syndicate was attempting to send the wildlife to China and Hong Kong, concealed inside toys, chip containers, powdered chocolate tins, deep-fryers and rice cookers.

Most of the reptiles were rehoused to local sanctuaries, schools and zoos, and some sent to the Australian Museum to help develop tools to detect these animals being trafficked out of Australia in the future. Sadly, 12 of the smuggled reptiles died following their ordeal, either from suffocation or trauma.

The DELWP has a lot of tools and significant powers under the Widlife Act 1975 and other legislation to investigate, including surveillance devices, search warrants and dedicated resources, said Mr Bruce.

"We identified, though, that we need to do better," he said. "The government has invested \$36 million to improve our efforts in recent times. In the past three years, DELWP has doubled the number of wildlife forest officers from around 35 to 70. I'd like to think that Victoria is leading the way with significant intelligence by having a dedicated intelligence function."

DELWP also uses the AELERT forum, a contact point to share information on wildlife trafficking compliance in resource management, and attends its bi-annual conference, he added.

Despite all the combined intelligence and resources, investigators need help from the public to bring criminals to justice, he said.

"We are proud of our wildlife investigations but are not satisfied with the outcome," said Mr Bruce. "Wildlife is difficult to detect. All sorts of different methods are being used to conceal the animals, providing false names and false documentation. We have all the information we need to prosecute and are bringing some to justice but have trouble locating other key suspects even when we have CCTV footage of them delivering parcels to post offices."

Mr Bruce said investigators need the community to help identify these criminals who may have purchased some of the animals from legitimate pet owners.

"There may be signs that are not quite right," he said. "Take a look at the CCTV images on Crime Stoppers (www. crimestoppers.com.au). From our investigations in the past year we've found that alleged offenders usually use post offices close to where they live or work. Parcels have been sent from, East Kew, Airport West and Melbourne. Somebody may recognise them!"

WHAT CONTRIBUTES TO WILDLIFE TRAFFICKING?

Wildlife based tourism and social media have done wonders to promote Australian wildlife and help expand dialogue on conservation and wildlife issues, but also contribute to the growth of wildlife trafficking.

Tour and travel operators are in an excellent position to not just educate tourists about wildlife, but also inform them about wildlife trafficking and to be alert for suspicious activities. A great example is Taronga Conservation Society Australia's 'Wildlife Witness' app that enables users to directly report illegal wildlife trade!

Developed in partnership with TRAFFIC, this world-first app enables users to report suspicious illegal wildlife activity by taking a photo, pinning the exact location of an incident and sending these important details to TRAFFIC. These reports are then analysed by a Wildlife Crime Data Analyst and credible incidents will be referred to enforcement agencies for action.

Social media also offers good conditions for wildlife trafficking to thrive, making it the "new epicentre" for wildlife trade, according to TRAFFIC. Not only are the social platforms easily accessible and have a high number of users, but it's also good for sellers who can put up photographers and detailed information about the animals.

According to the International Fund for Animal Welfare (IFAW) Oceania, five years ago IFAW investigated the sale of endangered wildlife on online marketplaces accessible in Australia and New Zealand and found a wide variety of species available, most of them offered on two of Australia's most popular trading websites, despite those sites having policies that prohibit trade in endangered and protected species. The report revealed a 266% increase in the number of advertisements for endangered wildlife since comparable research in 2008!

WHAT'S PUTTING WILDLIFE AT RISK?

Besides social media, poachers are also trawling scientific papers for information on the location and habits of new, rare species! David Lindenmayer, Australian National University professor and award-winning scientist in conservation and biodiversity, co-published an essay in Science that scientists may have to rethink how much information they publicly publish.

The principles of open access and transparency have led to the creation of detailed online databases that pose a very real threat to endangered species, he said. For example, in the case of the endangered pink-tailed worm lizard, biologists working in NSW are required to provide location data on all species they discover during scientific surveys to an online wildlife atlas. After data was published, the landowners began to find trespassers on their properties. The interlopers had scoured online wildlife atlases.

"There is thinking around a risk strategy for reducing data accessibility to try and thwart poachers. Although this is naïve in some ways because criminals are very savvy when it comes to new technology and accessing key information," said Prof Lindenmayer. "The extent of poaching is increasing and wildlife is under enormous pressure. Far better regulation of data streams needs to occur to prevent data access to the wrong people."

Prof Lindenmayer said the pet industry has also contributed to the illegal wildlife trade. "The pet industry is a major contributor to the trade of wildlife. That was formally called out in the Ecological Society of America in 1996," he said.

Demands for rare and threatened animals, like Chinese Cave Geckos, means massive poaching is happening, he continued.

"But these problems cover not just the illegal trade in reptiles, but also birds and even spiders -wild caught tarantulas! The pet trade in frogs was the basis for the disease being spread that has decimated frogs around the world," he said. "The pet industry needs to better regulate what is suitable and not suitable as a pet, and there needs to be far greater fines and jail sentences for breaches."

DETECTOR DOGS SAVING WILDLIFE

Conservation detection dogs play a vital role in helping to protect Australia's threatened species for recovery programs and conservation research. They also work to protect Australia from exotic pests and diseases. The Department of Agriculture and Water Resources' detector dog teams are deployed at international passenger terminals, mail facilities and courier depots throughout the country to find items that could bring pets or disease into Australia, such as certain food, plant material and animal protects.

Well-trained detection dogs are clearly a powerful resource in the protection of endangered species. So why are they not being used particularly at mail facilities to detect wildlife being smuggled out of Australia?

An Australia Post spokesperson would not comment on the screening processes in mail centres, saying "screening of postal



articles for contraband is the responsibility of Australian Border Force, the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources, and state and territory police forces. Australia Post works closely with law enforcement agencies where appropriate."

ABF Superintendent Fleming said the agency does not have detector dogs that work in wildlife trafficking because they have a range of effective border security processes in place that include working with other agencies.

"The technology and resources that we have to detect wildlife smuggling are pretty strong. We have good x-ray facilities and physical inspection," he said. "Or the use of intelligence - where we work around the information we get from offshore and information we share in amongst all of our state and federal colleagues - helps us to do good profiling in syndicates that we think are involved. That is something we are working on very strongly now in developing those profiles so that we can better detect attempted smuggling at the border."

Detector dog trainer Steve Austin, Australia's most experienced dog trainer for detection work including conservation and narcotics, believes wildlife trafficking investigations would be greatly enhanced by the use of canine scent detection.

Having worked with and trained canines in wildlife conservation detection for many years, Mr Austin said a dog will track the species by the scent of their feathers, fur, urine and scat. Sometimes a dog also utilises the sound of the species ()

The way these animals are concealed are extremely cruel; taped up head to tail to avoid animals making any noise > to aid detection. "It's like having a GPS on four legs!" he added.

Mr Austin encouraged the commencement of a trial program to undertake detection monitoring in key locations utilising professionally trained detection dogs.

"Also, a trial of a dedicated Wildlife Canine Detection Unit for wildlife trafficking in key areas in Australia would provide alarming statistics of this callous treatment of our wildlife," he said.

As police investigations have shown wildlife trafficking often has the same route as narcotic trafficking, if a canine carried out routine wildlife detection, it has the potential to also sniff for narcotics.

Take a look at Kenya's innovative technique – a "potential game-changing technology" known as RASCO (Remote Air Sampling for Canine Olfaction), which can help dogs to detect illegal wildlife products more easily, according to the World Wildlife Fund.

The way it works is initially, air is suctioned out from a targeted shipping container before being passed through filters. The trained dogs are then presented with the filters and are able to sniff out even the tiniest amounts of ivory, rhino horn and other illegal wildlife products. They have been trained to sit if a specific illegal wildlife part is detected, meaning that a container holding illicit items can be easily identified.

According to WWF, so far expert sniffer dogs have been successfully detecting

illegal wildlife products (including ivory) from various containers in Mombasa port and in transit, by going from container to container. Not only could this new technology address some logistical challenges found in previous methods (ie high volume of containers and hot working conditions for the dogs) but is also quicker and easier for both officers and dogs and can be carried out in climate-controlled rooms. This means that a higher volume of containers can be 'sniffed out' in more comfortable conditions for the dogs.

RASCO is championed by WWF, TRAFFIC and Kenya Wildlife Service (KWS), which has been using sniffer dogs since 2015 with ongoing technical and management support from the African Wildlife Foundation who sourced and trained the dogs and trained KWS handlers.

CAPTIVE BRED OR CAUGHT FROM THE WILD?

Another revolutionary 'wildlife protection' tool is being developed by the University of New South Wales in collaboration with Taronga Conservation Society, University of Technology Sydney and the Australian Nuclear Science Technology Organisation (ANTSO).

Dr Kate Brandis, research fellow at the Centre for Ecosystem Science of UNSW, said: "Laundering of wild animals as being bred in captivity is a big issue. Identifying where these animals come from helps with wildlife law enforcement. We have developed a revolutionary way to

determine if a confiscated animal is being illegally trafficked."

The new technique identifies chemical markers in keratin (such as quills, feathers and hair) that establishes with more than 96% accuracy whether the animal has been eating a natural, wild diet or a captive diet. Trade of animals is restricted to no trade or in some cases, if bred in captivity, legally allowed to be traded. What researchers have found is happening is animals are being taken from the wild and the paperwork being forged to show they've been bred in captivity and are passed off as captive bred.

"For wildlife conservationists, it's been immensely frustrating knowing that animals are being caught in the wild and passed off as captive-bred with forged paperwork, but with no way to prove it," she said.

Dr Brandis said previous techniques haven't been able to show whether an animal has been captive bred or wild caught.

"Unless you have a long history of parental information, you can't tell using DNA if a reptile came from the wild or raised by a breeder. That's what our tool can do - tell you the difference," she said. "With this information, authorities can go down the path of enforcement. Our tool will also give validity that the animal has been captive bred."

Dr Brandis said more funding is needed to continue with their research.

"We are also talking to collaborators in south east Asia where laundering is happening, and with partners in Malaysia," she said.

Looking into the future, the challenge of protecting native Australian wildlife is immense. To help combat wildlife trafficking, Australian government departments and agencies investigating wildlife trafficking are encouraging the public to report suspected breaches of international wildlife trade laws. SHOAL TO THE RESCUE

Ornamental Fish International (OFI) and the Ornamental Aquatic Trade Association (OATA) are just two of the growing number of official organisations pledging support to Shoal, a new partnership set up on 1 March, 2019, with the aim of conserving freshwater fish species. Although Shoal is not specifically an aquarium trade-related initiative, the fact that the ornamental aquatic industry actively supports the sustainable use of natural resources, ethical harvesting and conservation (hence the Project Piaba slogan: 'Buy a Fish, Save a Tree'), makes the decision to join a very sensible and logical one. Both these major trade organisations have joined as Strategic Partners and line up alongside a diverse group of like-minded bodies. These include the all-encompassing World Wildlife Fund, Global Wildlife Conservation and the Zoological Society of London, as well as more aquatically specific agencies like the Freshwater Fish Specialist Group, and more species-focussed associations like the Parosphromenus Project (which specialises in licorice gouramis of the genus Parosphromenus) and the Mahseer Trust (which has the mahseers - the giant cyprinids of the genera, Tor, Hypselobarbus, et al - as its flagship species).

Strategic Partners "comprise a group of institutions that contribute, in a coordinated way, towards the implementation of Shoal's principal objectives." These include the development of "sustainable solutions which ensure a future for freshwater fish, their habitats, and the people who depend upon them", all of which fall fairly and squarely within the philosophy and practice of today's aquarium industry.

Having said this, since over 90% of freshwater species found in trade are captive-bred, why should our sector wish to become involved with an organisation that, at least, in its initial stages, is prioritising non-trade projects, such as saving the endangered cyprinid, *Telestes croaticus*, in Croatia... or the equally endangered hump-backed mahseer (*Hypselobarbus mussulah* – formerly known as *Tor mussulah*) of Southern India... or helping to create a conservation plan for Sulawesi's Ancient Lakes?

The answer is quite simple and, since OATA and several of its member businesses have been involved in the actual creation of Shoal, it would seem most appropriate to allow Dominic Witmee, OATA's Chief Executive, to explain: "The conservation of freshwater aquatic species globally is very important... for biodiversity, for the livelihoods of those that depend on freshwater fisheries around the world, and even for our own health and wellbeing. Our industry relies on a sustainable source of live fish for the aguarium trade. While many of the tropical freshwater fish within the home aquarium industry are captive reared it is important to be able to access sustainably caught wild fish to refresh genetic stock... I believe as an industry we can make a positive contribution to the long-term conservation of freshwater fish by supporting sustainable practices and projects to conserve local populations. It therefore seems natural to support this new fundraising platform."

Of course, it is still far too early to assess how effective or otherwise Shoal will prove to be in achieving its targets, or to see how many other trade organisations besides OATA and OFI will join the initiative. Nonetheless, the mere fact that both these important trade bodies are backing the project gives us cause for optimism.

INDONESIA: NEW ORGANISATION SET TO BYPASS CORAL BAN?

The Hawaiian saga continues to rumble on from one decision to an amended decision, to another, and to yet another....

PHOTO CREDIT: BERNARD DUPONT – REPRODUCED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CREATIVE COMMONS ATTRIBUTION–SHARE ALIKE 2.0 GENERIC LICENSE The latest developments concern Senate Bill 931, which is aimed at prohibiting "harvesting aquatic life for commercial aquarium purposes by any means..." Clearly, approval of such a Bill would, or could, have sounded the 'death knell' for Hawaii's ornamental marine sector. However, after going through various committee discussions, a recommendation was made that the Bill be passed, but with certain amendments.

At first sight, the amendments don't appear to make things much better for the industry, but there may just be some glimmer of hope, if not for today, for two years' time. The gloom arises from the fact that a moratorium will be imposed and that all harvesting of aquatic life for commercial aquarium purposes using fine-mesh nets or fine-mesh traps will be prohibited. Should anyone be caught in possession of such nets or traps, they will be subjected to a US\$5,000 fine.

In his address referring to the amendments, Senator Kai Kahele, chair of the Water and Land Committee, made it clear that, in the face of the contrasting opinions of the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) - which has regularly collaborated with fishers and the industry (e.g. via PIJAC) and maintains that the fishing is sustainable, and that of the environmental groups which maintain that it isn't, there is a need for an independent Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Responsibility for carrying out this EIS will fall on the Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii (RCUH), which will be required "to submit a progress report to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the Regular Session of 2020." Further, the Governor will be required "to be the accepting authority and to accept the environmental impact statement no later than twenty days prior to the Regular Session of 2021."

The DLNR will be intimately involved in the process as it has been directed to establish a marine aquarium fishing advisory group "to guide the RCUH and Office of Hawaiian Affairs toward completion of the environmental impact statement and cultural impact statement." The advisory group will consist of the Administrator of the Division of Aquatic Resources, a representative of the commercial aquatic industry, a representative of a conservation organisation, and a representative of a fishing or fishermen's association or group.

It is envisaged that, following the submission and acceptance of the EIS, the moratorium will be repealed on 30 June, 2021. This is the glimmer of hope that I referred to above, in the sense that we are not talking about a definite and permanent closure of the sector, but one over which a decision will be taken at the end of June 2021.

At the time of writing, there is, obviously, no way of predicting the outcome, but if the DLNR's findings and conclusions arrived at over the past few years turn out to be sound, and if due and fair consideration is given to the findings of the EIS, we could be looking at a re-opening of the fishery in two years' time. Or am I being too optimistic?

FARM INVASIONS **ARE NOT PASSIVE RESISTANCE**

Comparing farm invasions to the passive resistance championed by Martin Luther King Jr is ridiculous and dangerous, Minister for Agriculture David Littleproud said today.

A manifesto published in the West Australian today shows the vegan activist group Direct Action Everywhere claims it is heavily influenced by the American icon.

"Invading family farms where children live should not be compared to passive resistance," Minister Littleproud said.

"It's dangerous and I think if it continues, someone will be hurt or far worse. "Passive resistance doesn't include breaking into people's properties.

"If the people invading family farms really think they're engaging in passive resistance then they're deluded.

"Vegans are important to the farm sector and consume lots of farm product. "Many vegans have contacted my office saying they don't support the actions of those invading farms.

"Australia is a great democracy which allows open debate, and that's the forum to express opinions - not by trespassing and scaring the living daylights out of farmers and their families.

"The states still need to do more to beef up trespass laws and needs to take this issue seriously."

Minister Littleproud was a driving force behind moves by the Federal Government to have organisations misusing farmers' personal information, such as their personal addresses, exposed to fines of more than \$4 million.

When Parliament resumes, the Coalition Government will make it a priority to bring in penalties of up to 12 months jail for individuals who use a carriage service, such as the internet, to disclose personal information with the intention that another person would use that information to trespass on agricultural land.

GENERIC BRANDS MAKE OTHERS GERIATRIC

Converging forces. Increasing acceptance, indeed preference for house-brands and generic products, services and apps are symptoms and consequences of tectonic shifts in marketplace dynamics. It's a phenomenon which transcends categories, sectors and regions.

Projecting, protecting and deflecting brand names are becoming increasingly important, and difficult to both achieve and sustain.

Repeated exposure to non-branded or house-brand alternatives, with lower prices, satisfying quality and reassuring value is desensitising consumers and clients to the implied and perceived innate advantages, benefits and reassurances of recognised, respected and traditionally preferred brand names.

The progressive devaluation of longestablished brand names is being accelerated and compounded by the increasing use of online channels and forums, like Amazon Marketplace and eBay.

Consumers are inclined to go online and nominate product/service types and categories. Requests for information about, and the sources of, say, coffee are received by, collated, analysed and segmented by algorithms. This form of artificial intelligence may be unfamiliar with the number "43" or not recognise and associate "George Clooney" with the product, category or implied brands.

Put simply, algorithms do not recognise, respond to or understand many verbal nuances. Therefore, brand selection is determined by factors and influences well beyond the control and input of the individual and brand name owners, and numerical weightings can, and do, determine, and therefore nominate channel-owner, (read: Amazon, eBay, Facebook, Twitter, etc) generic and house-brands.

Branding's visual, verbal and special cues, which impact on and influence

consumer perceptions, preferences and selection are typically neutered in social media. So anti-social!

Advocates for artificial intelligence will rightly argue that the arithmetic formula applied by algorithms produce rational and statistically validated decisions and outcomes. That belies the reality that most buying decisions are heavily accented to emotions, perceptions and subjective determinants.

For the algorithms, it's a black or white issue. Consumers may recognise that their lifestyles, preferences and consumption take place in a world of "grey". Brand owners and managers will quickly find themselves in purgatory. The need to be, and the lure of being present online is understandable. Attendant costs and loss of control are often difficult to quantify.

EVIDENCE-BASED REALITY

A recent significant Australia-wide study by a global finance entity concluded that house-brand products in supermarkets were growing in both volume (up to 4 times that of established independent brands) and market-share.

Cost-of-living expenses, increasing utility costs and stagnant incomes were identified to be key influencing variables in this situation. On balance, that represented only part of the story. The migration of window-shopping to online channels and the presence of its virtual assistants, Siri, Alexa, Nina and Bixby were not considered.

At Easter time, in Christian-based communities, Cadbury's purple Easter eggs have an inextricable integrated presence in the minds of children, parents and chocoholics at large.

"The Battle for the Mind", a concept so strikingly and articulately expressed by marketing leaders, Jack Trout and Al Ries back in 1969, has been largely marginalised by mindless artificial intelligence, algorithms and the like.

WHERE'S THE VALUE?

These patterns transcend categories, nations and regions.Economic headwinds are suppressing the sale of new motor vehicles around the world. Preferences for specific brands and models remain.

However, a seismic shift is being witnessed in the servicing and maintenance of vehicles. Generic and house-brands, or non-original equipment manufacturer parts are being accepted by increasing numbers and percentages of consumers.

Similar circumstances are evident in sectors, like earth-moving equipment. Brand names Caterpillar, Komatsu and Hyundai dominate. Notwithstanding that dominance, acceptance of "unbranded" parts is increasing at a rate.

BRANDED ANSWER

In an emerging and surgent sea of house-brand products, the value and integrity of recognised, trusted, respected and preferred brands stand apart and proud in a cluttered, commoditised marketplace.

Concurrent Activities: CIPS Innovation Award; GlobalPETS Forum (Asia); China Import Pet Food Symposium; CIPS Global Ornamental Fish Championship; CIPS Global Grooming Conference & Championship, etc. foods, and breakfast cereals to increase both wholesale and retail prices were rejected by two major Australian national supermarket chains. Supplies ceased, and stock soon sold out. Consumers were confronted with empty shelves.

The key lesson learnt was that consumer behaviour reflected the attitude that the customers, typically the female headof-the-household, could do without shopping for those selected items from Coles and Woolworths. To sate the appetites and the preferences of pets and children, there were no acceptable alternatives to the nominated brands.

Confused? Don't be. The presence and importance of house-brand products will continue to grow. The best and most sustainable defence is ongoing and integrated investments in brand names. The optimum is to establish, and have the brand name accepted as the generic reference of the product, service, application and company.

Those brand names that readily come to mind include:

 Vegemite
- Google Windows iPhone
- Amazon

nor respected. The consequences

are typically immediate, sustainable and profound.

"Buts" and "Maybes" need to be considered in context. They are seldom barriers or impediments. Rather, they demand justification, and that is reasonable and ultimately reassuring. There are lessons aplenty awaiting those in the broader retail sector.

Imagine the scope possible for the Brexit negotiations between Britain and the European Union, and within Westminster. Accountability and justification apply to all. Funding, construction and the administration of a wall on the border between the United States of America and Mexico may well be another issue.

In that instance key questions relate to the aim itself. Some things are not negotiable, as evidenced in the attitudes of the US President and the Democrats in Congress. What is the aim? Raw political power. The proposed wall is simply a means to that aim.

GOOD TIMES AHEAD

With the effluxion of time, good times will return. In those periods, as now, it is important to not look or present "too good". Talking too much will have little or no audience. Don't stop dreaming. However, dreams and their content must never become the aim.

And yes, think. Share those thoughts. Develop, refine, reinforce and extend them. But avoid the temptation to make them the final objective. Innovate, create and simplify. Each is an essential attribute of disruption. Don't leave it to others to ask, "IF?"

RECALIBRATE

Volatility, toxicity and dysfunction are each components of the prevailing marketplace and, seemingly, the cultures of many entities throughout the world, across Australia, within communities and among peers, clients and associates.

At a time when all around you are losing their heads, a measure of stability, consistency and integrity is greatly valued. A measure of balance will enable the "ship" to be steadied, a new course to be set and broad horizons challenged and conquered. IF (only). Thank you Rudyard Kipling.



ANIMAL COMMUNICATION IN 3 EASY STEPS

How many times have you secretly wished you could talk to your pet? Wished they understood everything you've ever said and to let them know how much they mean to you?

I'm going to let you in on a secret... REASONS **WHY YOUR** PET BUSINESS **SHOULD DO CONTENT** MARKETING



Don't do content marketing? That's a shame – because I can quarantee your rivals do.

Content marketing - or using writing to publicise your business - is a form of marketing that every pet business owner should do, even sole traders.

The mistake a lot of pet business owners make is to think of content marketing as an expense. It's not – it's an investment in your future profits. That's why your rivals do it.

A strategic, well-planned content marketing program will help your pet business do five things:

- Generate more enquiries
- Convert more enquiries
- Establish yourself as an expert
- Boost your Google ranking · Bait and hook referral partners

1. GENERATE MORE ENQUIRIES

Imagine you've got a leaking toilet. So you do a Google search for "[Your suburb] plumber". Three names pop up. The first one doesn't have a website. The second one does, but it's got minimal content and it hasn't been updated for a long time. The third one has a website, it's packed with relevant content and it gets updated regularly.

Which would you choose? If you're like most people, you'd instinctively choose the third plumber. Funnily enough, the third plumber might be the worst of the bunch. But our unconscious brain assumes that if he's got the most interesting content, he must be the most professional plumber.

2. CONVERT MORE ENQUIRIES

Content marketing doesn't just generate more enquiries; it also converts more of them into sales.

Most people would agree that the third plumber would receive more calls than the other two. But imagine you decide to be thorough and get quotes from all three. Before you pick up the phone, your unconscious brain has already concluded that the third plumber is professional, the first plumber is sloppy and the second is somewhere in the middle.

Given those preconceptions, which plumber is likely to sound most credible? And whose prices are you least likely to question?

Thanks to his high-quality content marketing, plumber three is going to find it easier to win your business and justify his prices.

3. ESTABLISH YOURSELF AS AN EXPERT

Now imagine you meet the three plumbers at a dinner party. The first spends the night hiding in a corner, so you barely see him. The second one is visible, but doesn't say much. The third one stands in the centre of the room and talks constantly about toilets, pipes and drainage systems.

Which plumber would seem most knowledgeable and passionate about his craft? Businesses that pump out relevant, high-quality content are perceived as experts. Businesses that stay silent are easily overlooked.

4. BOOST YOUR GOOGLE RANKING

As a general rule, the more relevant, quality content you publish on your website, the higher it will rank in Google search results.

The two important words here are 'relevant' and 'quality'. If you're a plumber, it makes no sense to fill your website with articles about Donald Trump or Lady Gaga. You need to write about matters related to plumbing. You also need to ensure the content is well-written, otherwise Google will conclude your website is less important and deserves a lower ranking.

5. BAIT AND HOOK REFERRAL PARTNERS

A lot of small business owners know some or all of the first four points - but few realise that you can also use content marketing to build referral relationships.

Here's what you do. First, identify a potential referrer that could help your business - for example, our plumber might want to target a property manager. Second, think of a way to quote the referrer in one of your articles – 'The 5 biggest maintenance problems to look out for when renting a property', for instance. Third, pitch the idea to the referrer.

Now that you've broken the ice and done them a favour (by giving them free publicity), you've given yourself a chance of turning them into a long-term referral partner.

PRESIDENTS REPORT **BARRY CODLING**

As the FY19 financial year comes to an end, I reflect on some of the many challenges we faced together, with some leaving significant ongoing effects on the pet industry.

I recall the decision of the Victoria Government in legislating the banning of "the sale of puppies in pet shops" whilst most associations such as the RSPCA support this decision the flow on effect to the industry remains costly. By April 2020 Victorian breeders with more than 10 female dogs but capped at 50 dogs will have to seek ministerial approval and will be subject to stricter regulations. Further to this, the Victorian Government is proposing to make changes to the Domestic Animals Regulations 2015. These changes are necessary to successfully implement the Pet Exchange register, and to clarify and improve requirements. The proposed changes include a fee and new requirements for the Pet Exchange register, new changes to the micro chipping program and updated changes to pet shop record keeping.

The Western Australian Government are seeking consultation on Standards and Guidelines for the Health and Welfare of Dogs in WA as part of the Stop Puppy Farming initiative. The Draft Standards and Guidelines for the Health and Welfare of Dogs in WA are being developed by the DPI and Regional Development in consultation with the RSPCA and other experts in dog care and welfare.

The NSW Government passed a bill in Parliament to amend the Companion Animals Act 1998 and Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979. The Companion Animals and other Legislation Bill 2018 allows the NSW Government to implement recommendations made by the Joint Selection Committee Inquiry into Companion Animal Breeding Practices, and other changes in response to community feedback received in 2017 through the statutory review of the Companion Animals Regulation 2008. The changes include new requirements for people advertising dogs and cats for sale or to give away to include an identifying number – either the microchip number, a breeder identification number or rehoming organisation number.

In October 2018 the Senate published their report following a 5-month inquiry into the safety of pet food in Australia following recent animal deaths and strong consumer out complaints. The report largely centred around the fact that the Pet Industry is "self-regulated" thus requiring government intervention. The seven recommendations detailed in this report whilst supported by the PIAA will impose significant changes on how we operate as an industry and no doubt add cost through compliance and registration to all our members.

Already the PIAA has been notified by members and the concerned public in Queensland & Victoria because of the

legislation changes requiring anyone selling dogs to be a registered breeder. The impacts of these changes have already resulted in an increase in online sales, many that have been sold the wrong dog online or told it was a pure bred when it wasn't. There has also been an increase in unregistered breeders stealing breeder ID's and passing them off as their own online. Facebook sales continue to rise despite Facebook banning the sale of animals and livestock online.

The PIAA are committed to advancing the Pet Industry in Australia and the welfare of the pets and their owners, thus committing our resources to work with the Government in all aspects. As you may be aware we have made some structural changes within the PIAA to best position ourselves to tackle these challenges for our members, with the most recent being the new position of Membership Manager. Mr John Parkinson has fulfilled this part time position. His role is dedicated to directly working with the current and potential PIAA members to deliver against the core objectives of the organisation. John comes with a career of experience in leadership roles with 15 years within the pet industry in Australia, Johns commences in this role on 11th June.

We are about to issue our membership renewal invoices for the 2019-2020 financial year. We recognise that business is facing many challenges in the current climate and as a result have made the decision that our fees will remain the same as 2018-2019. For those renewing before June 30, you will have the opportunity to go into the draw to win a \$200 cash-back reward.
